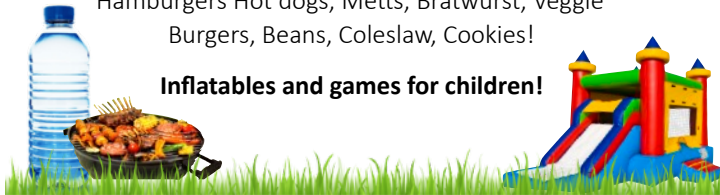

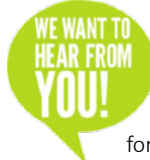


## LOST & FOUND
