The October Adult Forum will be Healthcare: A Continuing Saga

October 8 - We know we have a tremendous problem, now what do to help reduce it? Senior Program Officer, Kelly Firesheets, Preventing Opioid Misuse and Safety Net

October 15 - The National Institute Of Health and the crisis in research Funding: Speaker TBD. Over the years we have been able to count on the remarkable achievements in treatment of diseases derived from biomedical research supported by the NIH. This research, which has been one of America's great strengths, is now seriously threatened.

October 22 - The vaccination Connundrum: Speaker Dr, Robert Frenck, Jr Robert W. Frenck Jr., MD, received his undergraduate degree from the University of California at San Diego in 1977 followed by his MD from the University of Texas Health Science Center. He trained at the National Naval Medical Center in Bethesda, MD, completing his pediatric residency. After 3 years as a general pediatrician at the US Naval Hospital, Japan, he entered pediatric infectious disease fellowship training at the University of Texas Health Science Center. Dr. Frenck is board-certified in both pediatrics and infectious diseases.

October 29 - Emerging health Care Strategies; The changing face of Primary Care delivery, Concierge medicine, Direct Primary Care and beyond, speaker Dr. Lisa Larkin. Dr. Larkin Graduated from Yale University Medical School in 1988, did her Internship and Residency at the University of Chicago. Dr. Larkin said the Direct Primary Care concept adopted by her practice is an emerging business model that allows a simpler, more direct approach to medicine.
