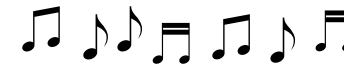

**November 12** - Dr. Warren Harding III on President Warren Harding. The 29th U.S. president, Warren Harding (1865-1923) served in office from 1921 to 1923 before dying of an apparent heart attack. Warren Harding, a Republican from Ohio, died while crossing the nation on a train tour during his third year in office. Speaker, Dr. Warren Harding III, MD, is an Orthopedic Surgery specialist in Cincinnati, Ohio. He attended and graduated from Loma Linda University School Of Medicine in 1967, having over 50 years of diverse experience. He is affiliated with many hospitals including Christ Hospital. Dr. Warren Harding also cooperates with other doctors and physicians in medical groups including Christ Hospital Orthopedic Associates LLC.

**November 19** - Dr. Lisa Larkin on Direct Primary Care and Concierge Medicine. Emerging health Care Strategies; The changing face of Primary Care delivery. Dr. Larkin Graduated from Yale University Medical School in 1988, did her Internship and Residency at the University of Chicago.
