October 2018: The Protestant Reformation: The Protestant Reformation occurred during a 250 year period (roughly 1350-1600) mostly in Western Europe. It was the result of a combination of several factors; emerging nationalism coupled with powerful monarchs; mercantilism replacing feudalism; Renaissance Humanism; perceived abuses of Roman Catholic leaders and- not the leas-, the printing press.
