First, you may choose to provide gifts for people. You may choose as many names as you like. For each name you choose you will be given a list of Christmas wishes to use as a guideline and asked to purchase gifts for a total cost of approximately \$30. Gifts are to be wrapped, labelled and returned to the church office (or the IPM office if you prefer) by Monday, December 10th.
