We will meet weekly for an outdoor Sunday Worship Service until the end of October. The worship service will be held in the parking lot. We discovered that this is a very shady spot! This week, we are spray painting circles in the parking lot for you to set up your chairs in. This will help to ensure social distancing.

We will continue to have an online worship service that will be released weekly on Saturday at 5:00 PM.



We are looking forward to gathering together for outdoor worship. While we are excited about being together again, the health and safety of our community are of utmost importance.

We request that you adhere to the following guidelines to help keep everyone safe and healthy:

1. Reservations are required

We will be using Eventbrite for all worship service reservations. Reservations are essential for contact tracing and are required. You may register for the worship service by using the Eventbrite link below or by emailing Jennifer Taylor (christianeducation@indianhillchurch.org).

2. Please Do Not Come to Sunday Worship If You Are Not Feeling Well

Out of respect for others, please do not come to worship if you or anyone in your household is not feeling well. If you have a fever of 100.4 or above, have had COVID-19 symptoms within the last 14 days, have been exposed to anyone with COVID-19 symptoms, or have a compromised immune system, please watch our Sunday worship service online. Thank you!

3. Observe 6' Social Distancing at All Times

6' social distancing is required at all times with non-family members.

4. A Touchless Experience

Please, no handshakes, hugging, and fist or elbow bumping. Waves and smiles from a 6' distance are encouraged!

5. Masks and Building Use

Everyone will be required to wear a mask.

The building will remain closed. Restrooms will not be available. Please plan accordingly.

6. What to Bring

Bring your own lawn chair.

7. Arrival

- Park your vehicle in the main parking lot (on the left when facing the church).
- Put on your face mask and gather your chairs.
- Walk towards the cemetery. Find a spray painted circle in the parking lot. Set up your chairs.
- Once you are settled in your spot, you may remove your masks.

8. Worship

-Your worship bulletin will be emailed to you on Friday or Saturday. Please print the worship bulletin at home or bring an electronic device with the worship bulletin loaded on it.

9. Departure

- When the worship service concludes, put your mask back on and pack up your belongings.
- Please respect 6 feet social distancing with those outside of your family as you return to your vehicles.
