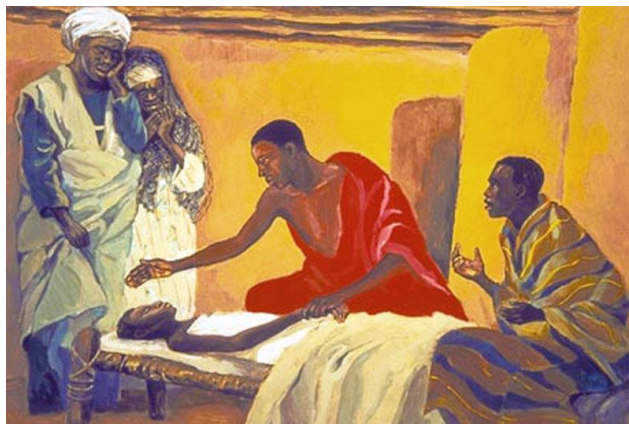

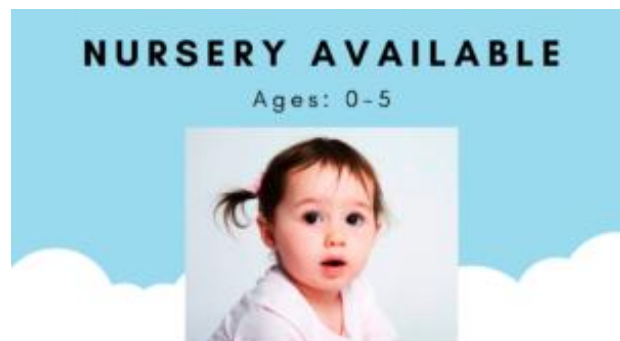
In light of the decision by the Indian Hill Church to welcome families and children into the sanctuary for all or part of worship, the Vestry-Session will continue to require that masks be worn at indoor services at this time.

1. All indoor worship attendees will continue to wear masks at this time.
2. We now have two households per pew.
3. Congregational singing has resumed.
4. We will continue to offer Eucharist at Episcopal services with the sacrament only in one kind (bread).
5. Reservations are still required for indoor worship services. Reservations can be made using the reservation links below, by emailing christianeducation@indianhillchurch.org or by calling the church 561-6805 ext. 307.

**Childcare is Now Open Every Sunday!
Ages 0 - Entering Kindergarten
Sunday School Resumes on Sunday, July 11**

The nursery is available for infants and children up to age 5. The safety and well-being of your children is our number one priority.



COVID Safety Protocols:

1. Child Care workers are fully vaccinated and will wear wear masks to model mask wearing for the children.

2. Children 0- 2 are not required to wear masks.
3. Children 3- 5 years old are strongly encouraged to wear a mask while in childcare, but will not be required to wear a mask.
5. If your child or anyone in your household is not feeling well, please do not send your child to the nursery. If your child has a fever of 100.4 or above, has had COVID-19 symptoms within the last 14 days or has been exposed to anyone with COVID-19 symptoms, please do not send your child to the nursery.
6. The nursery is located downstairs in room 10. We will have a Bible story and accompanying craft each Sunday. If the weather is nice, we will go outdoors to play on the playground.
7. Registration is required for worship in the sanctuary. A separate registration is not required for children.

We will be offering a Mission Camp for older elementary and middle school students. Students will learn about one Bible story each day and apply it to their daily life, learn new music, create a craft and participate in one mission activity each day. We will be preparing Power Packs, making sandwiches for Our Daily Bread and creating flower pots for a local retirement community.



We have developed the following COVID safety protocols to make Mission Camp as safe as possible for your children.

1. Students will be required to wear masks if indoors. Students will not be required to wear masks outdoors. Mission camp will be held outdoors, weather permitting.
 2. In case of severe inclement weather such as very heavy rain, lightening or very strong winds, we will come into the building with each pod assigned to a classroom. If we experience light rain, we will stay outside in tents.

We have developed the following COVID safety protocols to make VBS as safe as possible for your children.

1. Four- and Five-year-old children will be strongly encouraged to wear masks, but masks will not be required. Children entering first – third grade will be required to wear masks if indoors.
2. Children will stay in pods grouped by age. Pods will not interact unless they are outdoors.
3. The youngest children (4's and 5's, entering kindergarten) will be in an indoor classroom in the nursery school. Entering first, second, third and fourth grade children will meet outside.
4. Music class will be outside for all children.
5. Activity stations will include music, Bible story, snack, outdoor recreation, craft, and mission/outreach. There will no movement in the building. The children will stay in their classroom and the activity teachers will travel to them. Children will travel to activity stations outdoors.
