Announcements and Sunday Worship

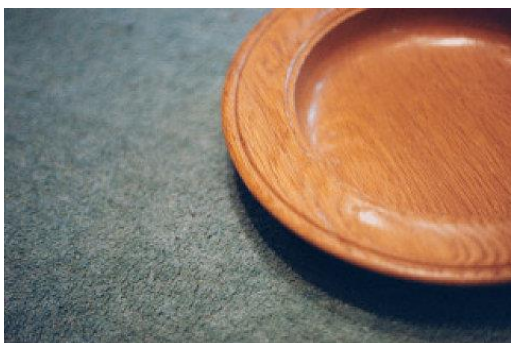
