Interparish Ministry (IPM) Christmas Program Donations Needed by December 6

IPM will be taking a new approach with their Christmas Program this year. Rather than buying gifts for specific individuals as we've done in the past, we're being asked to purchase items that will be used to fill the shelves of two Christmas Stores, one where caregivers will shop for their children and one where children will shop for their caregivers.

Seniors will be allowed to shop either for themselves or a loved one. In an effort to allow families to take ownership of this process each family will be asked to pay a nominal fee for their shopping experience.

A list of items needed to fill store shelves is listed below. In addition to providing gifts we are once again being asked to provide \$25 grocery store gift cards. These will be given to families along with a box of Christmas food. (Note: If you want your contribution of grocery store gift cards to appear on your IHC Giving Statement please contribute by check made out to Indian Hill Church with "grocery store gift cards" written on the memo line.)

Items needed for the Christmas Stores are as follows:

Infants – puzzles, trucks, blocks, pajamas, tummy time mats, rattles, bath toys, teething

Toddlers – Barbie dolls, character dolls from Disney's movie Frozen, remote control cars, pajamas, Baby Alive doll, Board Games, stuffed animals, Potato Heads, Play-doh, Paw Patrol

Elementary – Sport Team Hoodies, Pokemon, Action figures, Barbie dolls, Craft Kits, remote control cars, Bey Blades, Board games, stuffed animals, Star Wars "The Child", Legos, LOL! Surprise Dolls

Teen – Sport Team Hoodies, purse, wallet, makeup, Bluetooth Headphones, Legos, Charging Hub, Phone accessories

Adult – Hoodies, purse, wallet, makeup, cologne/perfume, makeup mirror, Bluetooth headphones, Crosswords, Sudoku, Bluetooth speaker, throw blanket, puzzles, mints, gum, candy

All items for the Christmas Stores and the grocery store gift cards should be delivered to the church office by Monday, December 6.
